Date: 3rd September 2002

- 21.15 Opening of the International Jury Meeting by the chairman
- 21.16 Attendance - as attached on the presence list
- 21.17 Most of the information regarding the race had been presented at the Team Captains Meeting that was also attended by the members of the International Jury
- 21.18 Schedule for the Jury for the race
- breakfast will be at 5.30 and packed lunches will be prepared
 - 6.00 - cars will be prepared for the members of the jury to take them to the competition area
- 21.25 Mr. Alexander Kochkine, UA3FW will act as individual terrain referee together with Mr. Miklos Venczel, HA0LZ
- terrain referee can use a camera, but cannot enter the start or finish area
- 21.29 Referees will keep records on paper, the organiser will provide paper, folders, pens, etc. and try to secure chairs
- referees will use radios
 - will be accompanied by technicians that will be of their assistance
- 21.35 Discussion about the proceedings when a competitor loses his/her chip
- the fine for the chip is 20 EURO
 - new rules, that are not valid for this competition say that the competitor who lost his/her chip will be disqualified
 - for this race the Jury decided to keep manual records for those competitors who lose their chip and followingly the jury will decide about disqualifying the competitor
