Date: 4<sup>th</sup> September 2002

- 15.47 Opening of the International Jury Meeting by the chairman
- 15.48 Preliminary results distributed to the members of the International Jury
- 15.55 Reports of individual referees
- Start referee
- at 10.00 – No. 127 – lady returned to the start not knowing what she is supposed to do
  - 10.35 – No. 240 – lady fell down, returned to the start with a damaged connector to her earphones and was not able to continue
  - these competitors should be listed not as disqualified, but as not completed
- Referee – No. 1 – no problems
- Referee – No. 2 – there were three bears near the control
- Referee – No. 3 – no problems
- Referee – No. 4 – no problem
- Terrain referee, Mr. Venczel – no problem
- Terrain referee, Mr. Kochkine – no problem
- Referee at the finish – 1 man came with a wrong chip number, the referee informed the persons working with the computers and they assured him that the problem was solved
- Total numbers of competitors - 306 in total
- 29 competitors – D 19
  - 29 competitors – D 21
  - 18 competitors – D 35
  - 14 competitors – D 50
  - 37 competitors – M 19
  - 61 competitors – M 21
  - 50 competitors – M 40
  - 37 competitors – M 50
  - 31 competitors – M 60
- there was a case that competitor originally start No. 320 started under No. 18, the situation was clarified during the competition
  - many competitors were over the given limit of time, not finding all the

foxes, it is proposed that the times and no. of found foxes should be left out on the final list of results
