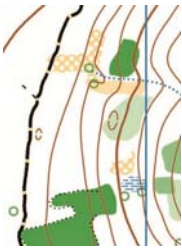

Terrain:

Classic competitions:

Mid-difficult terrain, few really difficult passages, enough tracks/roads, mostly passable forest but also dense and impassable sections. Competitors to read carefully maps and avoid dark green (impenetrable) passages. Due to the significant amount of precipitation last days meadows are overgrown with tall grass while the forest with undergrowth. Slightly swampy but easy passable areas are possible, too. Competitors have to have that in mind when choosing clothing and footwear.
